



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

ADVERTISING BYLAW

The Advertising Bylaw specifies the methods that the City may use to give notice of certain bylaws, resolutions, meetings, public hearings or other items that require advertising in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000. The proposed Advertising Bylaw will replace the existing Advertising Bylaw. The proposed bylaw must be advertised to inform citizens of the opportunity to present support for, or objections to, the bylaw at a required public hearing held prior to Council approving the new bylaw.

Advertising Bylaw No. 1197-2024

Bylaw No. 1197-2024 proposes a new Advertising Bylaw, that includes the repeal of the current Advertising Bylaw No. 1043-2019. Bylaw No. 1197-2024 proposes specific communication methods that Administration will be required to use to notify Leduc residents when advertising statutory notices, when required by the Municipal Government Act.

A copy of the proposed bylaws that will be presented to City Council may be inspected by the public between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. at the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Leduc Civic Centre, 1 Alexandra Park, 46th Avenue and 48A Street, Leduc, Alberta.
