

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE CITY OF LEDUC COMMUNITY STANDARDS BYLAW The Following Information is Common to the Bylaw Presented

The City of Leduc Community Standards Bylaw 711-2008 regulates the conduct and activities of people in public places and on privately owned property and immediately adjacent areas in order to promote the safe, enjoyable and reasonable use of such property for the benefit of all citizens in the city. The City of Leduc is holding a nonstatutory Public Hearing on proposed amendment to the Community Standards Bylaw to address upcoming legalization of cannabis by the Federal Government as it relates to public use of Cannabis.

Bylaw No. 981-2018

The purpose of proposed Bylaw No. 970-2017 is to amend Bylaw No. 981-2018, Part I – Purpose, Definitions and Interpretations, Part II – Public Behaviours, and Part VII – General to allow the City Manager to designate areas in which Cannabis use is prohibited.


A summary of the proposed changes is as follows:

- Update definitions to include Cannabis, Smoke and Vape
- Prohibit smoking or vaping of Cannabis in identified areas

A copy of the proposed Bylaw that will be presented to City Council may be inspected by the public from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon and 1:00 to 4:30 p.m. from Monday to Friday at the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Leduc Civic Centre, 1 Alexandra Park, 46th Avenue and 48A Street, Leduc, Alberta. Any person may also be heard by responding to the Mayor's call for delegations at the time of the Public Hearing.
