It was noted there was weak language around environmental preservation like encourage etc. Clarification is needed for 30m buffer (from seasonal wetlands? - not Telford Lake itself?) as well as "attractive fencing". There is no mention of lighting restrictions. Suggestion of motion sensor for lighting.
